

Swiss Graduate Jobmarket Monitor

Indicator S – Students

About

In the indicator "S –students" of the global survey, the CSNCH asked the opinion of students and graduates of universities in Switzerland. We needed to have a vision on how they see the job market for graduates. These results allow Career Services to adapt their coaching to best support students in their career paths.

The survey was done on Mentimeter and shared via social media, within the Career Services Network. 383 students and graduates participated in December 2020 (session 1) and 464 participated in April 2021 (session 2). The next session will be launched in Autumn 2021.

Development overall

In both surveys, the students see the job market quite pessimistic. And in both surveys the students expect an improvement of more or less the same extent.

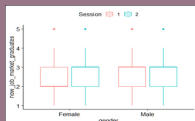


How do the students see the current job market for graduates? Analytics

(1 = very bad / 5 = very well)

Influence of the gender

In December 2020 (session 1 in orange), female students were more pessimistic about the job market than male students. In April 2021 (session 2 in green), there were no difference between male and female.



Influence of the degree

Master students were less pessimistic in April 2021 (session 2 in green) than in December 2020 (session 1 in orange). Bachelor students hadn't changed their mind between December 2020 and April 2021.



Has the pandemic affected their career plans?

(1 = not at all / 5 = very much)

In December 2020, the career plans of Bachelor students were quite not affected. The career plans of Master students were much more affected. In April 2021, the pandemic affected the career plans of Bachelor students much more than in December.
